Dr. David C. Ford

Dr. David C. Ford was raised in Wilmington, Delaware, and educated at Colgate University (BA in History), Oral Roberts University (Master of Divinity), and Drew University (Ph.D. in Church History and Historical Theology). He's in his 35th year of teaching Church History at St. Tikhon's Orthodox Theological Seminary.

Dr. David has devoted almost 40 years to the study of St. John Chrysostom's life and writings, some of which he has translated from the original Greek into contemporary English. These translations are presented in *St. John Chrysostom: Letters to Olympia*; *Sing to Your Soul*,

a three-volume set giving selected passages on about 60 different themes relating to the Christian life; and *Nine Sermons from the Life of St. John Chrysostom*. Many passages by Chrysostom, especially regarding marriage, are given in Dr. David's *Women and Men in the Early Church: The Vision of St. John Chrysostom*, which is a revised and expanded version of his doctoral dissertation.
